AN ORDNANCE, No. 5

Prohibiting automobiles and motor-cycles from speeding more than fifteen miles per hour, and prohibiting coasting, bicycle riding, horse back riding and driving on the sidewalks and prohibiting the placing of rubbish on streets and highways.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of Yorkana, that the driving of automobiles, or motor vehicles shall not exceed the limit of fifteen miles per hour, in said Borough, and any person violating the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine of not less than Five Dollars, and not more than Twenty Dollars.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to coast, ride bicycle, horse back, or driving vehicles with horses attached thereto on the sidewalks in said Borough, and any person violating this section shall pay a fine of not less than Two Dollars and fifty cents, and not more than Ten Dollars.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful to place or throw rubbish, garbage, offal, or waste, or any deleterious material on the public streets or highways of said Borough, and any person violating this section shall be subject to a fine of not less than Two Dollars and fifty cents, or more than Ten Dollars.

Section 4. All fines and penalties provided by this ordnance shall be collected, by proper legal proceedings before any Justice of the Peace within said Borough.
